

# Informed Choice

You can choose your job goal and the services you need to reach your goal. DVR will give you – and help you find – what you need to make informed choices. If you don't understand something, ask!

## A family member, a friend or an advocate can help make choices about your DVR services. You can get assessments that will help you and DVR know:

- If you are eligible for DVR services
- Your waiting list category
- What services you will need to reach your job goal

## You can make choices about your Employment Plan:

- Job goal
- DVR services you need
- Service providers
- Where you get services

## DVR can give you information about service providers and help you choose the one that will work for you:

- What services they have
- Their qualifications
- Cost
- What other consumers have said about the services
- If the service provider has helped other consumers reach their job goals

## You will work with DVR to choose the best way to buy the services you need to reach your job goal. Tell DVR:

- The best way to contact you – phone, mail, e-mail, etc.
- If you need information in an alternate format or translated to another language
