



Advanced Medical Assisting Course Description

Trinity Education Alliance's Advanced Medical Assisting teach learners to work side by side with doctors, nurses, and others on the health care team, treating patients from newborns to senior citizens. Learners will demonstrate a blend of varied skills including administrative, technical, communication and interpersonal abilities. After satisfactory completion, learners are qualified and equipped with knowledge and skills for certification exams for Medical Assisting, Phlebotomy and EKG Technician.



Content is divided into seven modules:

(Prerequisite: Part II: Anatomy and Physiology)
