

Phlebotomy Basics to Advanced Course Description

Trinity Education Alliance's Phlebotomy Technician program is a 5- week program that prepares learners to perform a variety of blood collection methods using proper techniques and precautions including: vacuum collection devices, syringes, capillary skin puncture, butterfly needles and blood culture specimen collection on adults, children and infants. Emphasis is placed on infection prevention, proper patient identification, proper labeling of specimens, and quality assurance. NAACLS Competencies for Entry-Level Phlebotomists are covered at a more detailed, intermediate, or advanced level.

PART II: Anatomy and Physiology of the Human Body including Medical Terminology

PART III: Phlebotomy Equipment and Procedures
