### Are you able to obtain, renew, or improve your Substance Abuse Credential?

State licensed personnel provide low cost and community-oriented *Introductory Education and Supervision* (100/40 hours) for the Jurisprudence Exam needed for Substance Abuse Counselor-in Training (SACIT), and Prevention Specialists in-Training (PSIT); *Advanced (C/SAC, PS) Education* (100-360/40-120 hours) and Supervision; *Specialized Education and Supervision* (30 hours) for the IMCS, ICS approved by the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services. CEU's available as well.

The Department of Labor predicts a 22% increase in jobs by 2025. Transformation Services Inc. (TSI) accepts job-related tuition reimbursement and, depending on your current employment status, you may be eligible for state Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) or Department of Vocational Rehabilitation (DVR) funding; this may cover the tuition and materials for the course. We also accept (*MyCAA*) for veterans' spouses. Call or email for program information format, cost etc.

In general, we accommodate most schedules, and offer Winter/Spring, Summer, and Fall/Winter semesters (either distance or in-person).
