

## Project SEARCH Fee Schedule

(Revised: November 2016)

\$ 600/month	<p><b>Project Search Skills Training and Reports:</b> Payable upon completion of acceptable service, timely monthly progress reports to DVR within 5 days of the conclusion of the previous month of service. First required service not to exceed 30 days from issue of service authorization. (Code 063)</p>
\$300	<p><b>Project SEARCH Job Plan, Meeting and Report:</b> Payable upon completion of acceptable meeting and plan/report to DVR within 5 business days of conclusion of this service. First required service not to exceed 30 days from issue of service authorization. (Code 024).</p> <p>***This service would occur with the PS provider 2-3 months prior to PS graduation. It occurs only IF the consumer has not already been hired and IF the consumer chooses to continue to work with the PS provider for job development services.</p> <p>The purpose is to pull together information learned about the consumer during Project SEARCH and identify the types of jobs that will be sought and the level of support that may be needed. DVR's Job Preparation and Development Plan report form can be used. Resume and Job Center of Wisconsin Registration to be submitted along with report.</p>
\$1,500	<p><b>All Hires During Project SEARCH Participation with Report:</b> Payable upon completion of acceptable service, timely monthly progress reports, and hire report to DVR within 5 business days of the conclusion of the previous month of service and within 5 days of hire. First required service not to exceed 30 days from issue of service authorization. (Code 024)</p> <p><b>Preferred Placement/Hire Outcome Payment:</b></p> <p>\$2,100 preferred outcome payment.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must have: 35+ hours per week and health insurance benefits or 35+ hours per week and \$12.00 hour.</li> </ul> <p>\$1,900 preferred outcome payment.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must have 20+ hours per week and health insurance benefits or 20+ hours per week and \$9.00 hour.</li> </ul> <p>\$1,500 payment all other.</p> <p>Note: Hire offer for less than 15 hrs per week will need DVR approval in advance.</p>
\$800/month	<p><b>Project SEARCH On the Job Supports and Reports:</b> Monthly rate payable</p>

up to 6 months	<p>if the consumer is employed <b>during</b> their participation at Project SEARCH, upon completion of acceptable service, and timely monthly progress reports to DVR within 5 business days of the conclusion of the previous month of service. First required service not to exceed 30 days from issue of service authorization. (Code 028)</p> <p>***Used only for consumers who have been HIRED while still participating in Project SEARCH. <i>This rate applies for all consumers regardless of being hired within/outside of the host business.</i> If the consumer is hired after graduation, general job coaching fees apply. See the DVR Statewide Fee Structure for rates.</p>
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**CONSIDERATIONS**

- **This service does not require a Systematic Instruction: Job and Task analysis.**
- DVR pays a monthly fee for the Project SEARCH program. Project SEARCH is a braided funding model, meaning that DVR is not the only payer for this program. There is another fee that is paid for by a local school district, long term funding sources, or even a private pay situation.
- This is a PS fee schedule only. It should be used *while* the DVR consumer is an active Project SEARCH intern, e.g. has not yet graduated from their Project SEARCH class.
- DVR consumer involved in Project SEARCH may or may not be a consumer in need of supported employment services. They may or may not have long-term funding.
- Once the DVR consumer graduates from Project SEARCH, the most appropriate DVR fee schedule/service structure should be followed for that consumer.
  - Examples:
    - a) A consumer needing supported employment services would follow the Supported Employment fee schedule.
    - b) A consumer needing less employment support would follow the Job Preparation and Development fee schedule.

<p>\$362.43/semester</p> <p><i>\$262.43 tuition</i></p> <p><i>\$100 course fee</i></p>	<p><b>UW-Whitewater Tuition:</b> Payable when a non-high school student is accepted into the Project SEARCH program. (Code 063).</p>
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\*\*\*All other services for non-high school students follow the Project SEARCH fee schedule listed above.
