June Local Employment and Unemployment Data Released

MADISON – The Department of Workforce Development (DWD) today released the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) estimates of unemployment and employment statistics for Wisconsin metropolitan areas, major cities and counties in Wisconsin for June 2020.

In brief, the non-seasonally adjusted data for Wisconsin shows:

- **Metropolitan Statistical Areas:** Preliminary June 2020 unemployment rates decreased in Wisconsin's 12 metro areas over the month and increased over the year. Unemployment rates for June range from 6.9 percent in Wausau to 10.0 percent in Milwaukee-Waukesha-West Allis.
- **Municipalities:** Preliminary June 2020 unemployment rates decreased in Wisconsin's 34 largest cities over the month and increased over the year. Unemployment rates range from 6.8 percent in Fitchburg to 12.8 percent in Milwaukee.
- **Counties:** Preliminary June 2020 unemployment rates decreased in all of Wisconsin's 72 counties over the month and increased over the year. Rates range from 5.7 percent in Lafayette to 20.0 percent in Menominee.
