- Subject: Worker's Compensation Rate Changes

The Worker's Compensation Act has been amended to increase the maximum compensation rate to \$549 per week for temporary total disability, permanent total disability and death benefits for injuries occurring on or after January 1, 2000 and before January 1, 2001. The new average weekly wage that will result in the new maximum rate will be \$823.50.

Using this new wage will raise the maximum death benefit for fatal injuries occurring on or after January 1, 2000 to \$164,700.

The maximum weekly indemnity rate for permanent partial disability will remain \$184 for injuries occurring on or after January 1, 2000. There is no increase.
