<u>To</u>: Claims Handling Offices for Insurance Carriers and Self Insured Employers <u>From</u>: Frances Huntley-Cooper, Division Administrator <u>Subject</u>: NEW CHANGE TO ICMS FOR MEDICAL REPORTS

<u>Purpose</u>: To inform claim handling offices that beginning in November 2009 the Division added a feature to its web based Pending Reports application that requires insurers to provide medical reports for claimants who have had surgery but have 3 weeks or less of lost time.

Background: Evidence shows us that despite the requirement per Wis. Stat. Chapter 102.13(2)(c), effective April 1, 2006, we are not getting medical reports for claimants who've had surgery but have 3 weeks or less of lost time. In order to enforce compliance a change has been made to the pending reports.

<u>Action Requested</u>: For any claim that has 3 weeks or less lost time, that is not an amputation, severance or hernia, does not have a balance due and does not have a medical report status or expected date, <u>internet users must now answer this question when submitting a WKC-13 "Has</u> <u>the claimant either had or is scheduled for surgery to treat his or her injury?</u>" If this question is not answered the user cannot move the claim into the next appropriate status.
